Importance of ICCP

ICCP is an endeavour towards preparation of a group of health care professionals with expertise which is essential for effective implementation of infection control practices across all health care settings. By the infection control certification program, we aim at developing specialized nurses in this field, equipped with adequate knowledge and skill needed for the maintenance of a safe hospital environment and health care delivery practices.

Credentials

Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences has conducted this certification program since 2011 and has certified more than 640 RN from various parts of India over 36 Batches.

Training Overview

Infection control certification programme is a distance education programme delivered over a period of 8 weeks with 6 days mandatory contact sessions. There shall be an examination at the end of the course and the final evaluation is based on the completed log book, written exam and viva voce. Contact classes are arranged in two sessions of 3 days each.

Training package:

This includes printed course materials, log book and lectures by experienced resource personnel and field visit during contact programmes

Eligibility for admission

- Diploma in GNM /Post Basic B Sc Nursing/ B Sc Nursing degree/ Msc Nursing Degree
- Has an **active license** from any state nursing council in India.
- **Currently working** in a hospital where course related activities can be performed

Fees Structure:

Total Training fee:

Rs. 10000 + 18% GST/- Rs.11800.

Registration fee Rs. 1000/-

(along with application)+ Course fee Rs. 9000 + GST 1800 (time of admission).
